Zero Suicide — How This Important Program Can Help Save Lives

AmeriHealth Caritas New Hampshire is excited to offer a training entitled Zero Suicide — How This Important Program Can Help Save Lives. This training session will be led by AmeriHealth Caritas New Hampshire clinical educators who have been trained in Zero Suicide techniques. This opportunity is being provided at no cost to AmeriHealth Caritas New Hampshire providers. Please read on for more information and to register for this session.

What is Zero Suicide?

The foundational belief of Zero Suicide is that suicide deaths for individuals under the care of health and behavioral health systems are preventable. For systems dedicated to improving patient safety, Zero Suicide presents an aspirational challenge and practical framework for systemwide transformation toward safer suicide care. Providers will learn the fundamentals of the Zero Suicide framework and how to implement them in their own practices.

What are the learning objectives of this program?

- Providers should be able to have an understanding of the Zero Suicide program and its importance.
- Providers should leave being able to implement strategies in their own practices to prevent suicide.

What are the goals of this session?

- Discuss the elements of Zero Suicide.
- Present initiatives and strategies providers can use to support suicide prevention in their own practices.

- Physical health providers.
- Clinical and nonclinical staff.

- Federally qualified health center/rural health clinic/individualized health care plan providers.

Do I need special equipment to attend?
