Investment Impact

Strengthening the Family Resource Center Network

- Granite United Way has provided **funds ranging from \$7,000 to \$10,000 to 10 Family Resource Centers** within its service area.
- These funds have played a vital role in **stabilizing operations during a time of economic uncertainty**, ensuring the continuous delivery of essential programming and services.
- **Key priorities were supported**, including quality improvement initiatives, infrastructure development, and the expansion of family support programs.
- **Targeted investment advances Adverse Childhood Experiences prevention strategies** while bolstering family and community-level protective factors.

Advancing Continuous Quality Improvement (CQI)

- Granite United Way has prioritized assisting Family Resource Centers in achieving or maintaining the **Family Resource Center of Quality (FRC-Q) designation**, a hallmark of excellence unique to New Hampshire's FRC network.
- This **designation reflects adherence to the highest standards** in family support practices, fostering confidence among families and stakeholders.
- These efforts **ensure the consistent delivery of exceptional services** across the entire network.

Expanding and Sustaining Core Programming

- **Early Childhood Developmental Screenings** to identify and address developmental concerns early.
- **Teen-focused Programs** promoting healthy decision-making and life skills.
- Family Workshops designed to enhance communication and build stronger interpersonal bonds.
- Granite United Way provided **advanced professional development for 80 family support professionals from 16 Family Resource Centers** in Trust-Based Relational Intervention (TBRI) certification training. This **evidence-based program** equips professionals with trauma-informed care techniques to effectively address complex family dynamics.
